

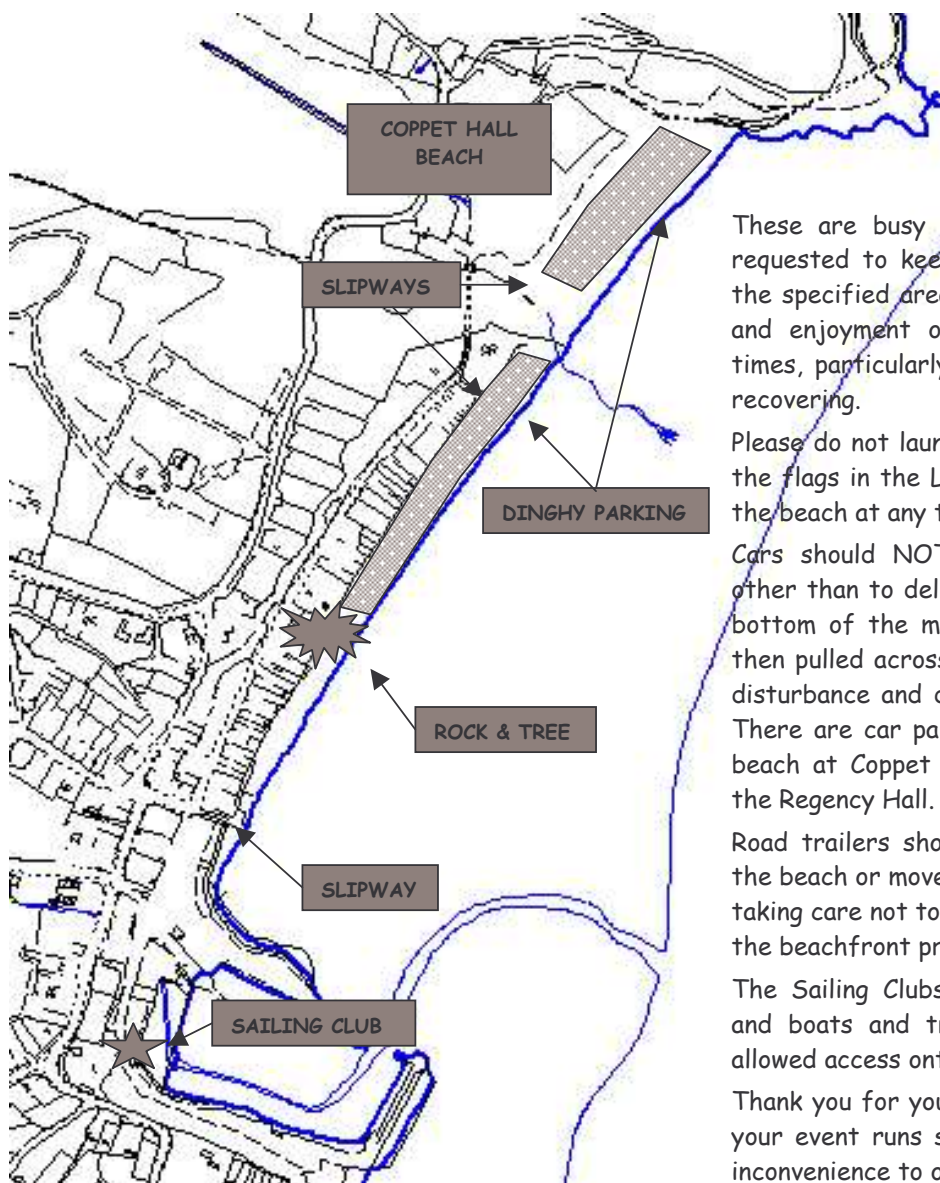
WELCOME TO SAUNDERSFOOT SAILING CLUB

Saundersfoot Sailing Club extends a warm welcome and honorary membership to all Supernova competitors and your families during the course of your championships and we hope you will enjoy your time with us here in Saundersfoot.

Registration and daily signing on and off procedures will take place at the Clubhouse where a weather forecast, tide times, all notices to competitors and results will be displayed, along with a list of all planned social events. Changing and shower facilities are available at the Clubhouse and refreshments will generally be provided before and after racing each day.

Chandlery is available from Jones and Teague on Saundersfoot Harbour, also at Tenby Marine, at Kelpie Boats at Pembroke Dock and Dale Sailing at Neyland Marina. The Club also holds a small stock of chandlery items, contact the Beach Master for further details.



Dinghy parking for the duration of the event will be on the northern end of the Main Beach and at Coppet Hall Beach as indicated on this plan.

These are busy family beaches and you are requested to keep boats grouped together in the specified areas and to respect the safety and enjoyment of other beach users at all times, particularly when rigging, launching and recovering.

Please do not launch or recover boats between the flags in the Lifeguard patrolled portion of the beach at any time.

Cars should NOT be taken onto the beach other than to deliver and remove boats to the bottom of the main slipway and boats should then be pulled across the beach by hand to avoid disturbance and danger to other beach users. There are car parks in close proximity to the beach at Coppet Hall, on the Harbour and at the Regency Hall.

Road trailers should either be removed from the beach or moved onto the pebble bank taking care not to impede access from the beachfront properties.

The Sailing Clubs dinghy park is already full and boats and trailers will not generally be allowed access onto the Harbour car park.
