### Notice of Race

#### 1. Organizing authority

The organising authority is Fishguard Bay Yacht Club and the Supernova Class Association.

#### 2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Supernova Class Rules and rules as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

**Local Rules:** entrants are prohibited from entering the shipping channel when commercial ferry traffic is entering or leaving Fishguard Harbour.

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

#### 3. Classes and eligibility

Racing will take place in Supernova Class dinghies. All competitors must be members of the Supernova Class Association.

All boats must comply with the Supernova class measurement rules as amended by the Class Association.

#### 4. Facilities parking and boat park.

Entrants will be honorary members of Fishguard Bay Yacht Club for the duration of the event. The Yacht Club is located at Quay Street, Lower Town, Fishguard, Dyfed, SA65 9NB. ## 5. Times

All boats must register. Registration will take place at Fishguard Bay Yacht Club, starting at 9:00 pm on Friday 25 May 2006.

Registration will close at 11:00h on Saturday 26 May.

There will be a briefing for competitors in the vicinity of the clubhouse at 11:00h on Saturday 26 May. There may be a further briefing at 9:00h on Sunday, if the Race Officer feels it is necessary.

## 6. Entries

The entry fee for the event is: £43. A discount of £5 will be made for entries before 5 May 2007 by Ian Casewell at 7 Pine Drive, Finchampstead, Wokingham, Berks RG40 3LD. Cheques should be made out to Supernova Class Association. The fee includes dinner on Saturday and lunch after racing on Sunday. Fee for partners is dinner at £12.00 and lunch at £6.00

All competitors under the age of 18 years at the time of the event are required to complete a parental declaration form, signed by their parent or guardian, in addition to an entry form. The parental declaration form will be available at registration.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be issued upon registration at Fishguard Bay Yacht Club and can be viewed on the Supernova Website with a link to Fishguard Tourist Information maps of location and streets.

## **8. Racing Area**

The racing area will be Fishguard Bay.

## **9. Disclaimer of Liability**

A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By launching or going afloat, the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and that her crew is competent to sail and compete in them. The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000. Nothing done by the organizers can reduce the responsibility of the boat, nor will it make the organizers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organizers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beach masters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.

## **10. Rights to Use Names and Likenesses**

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to the event. They also allow their names, age category, Club and boat details to be displayed in competitors lists prior to the event and in results, on a Fishguard Bay Yacht Club website and in other publications.
