The Hoe

Plymouth Hoe, referred to locally as the Hoe, is a large public space in the English port city of Plymouth. The Hoe is adjacent to the seafront and commands magnificent views of Plymouth Sound, Drake's Island, and across the Hamoaze to Mount Edgecombe in Cornwall.

About the sailing club

The sailing club is located just after you drive/walk up from the Barbican and just before you go up onto the Hoe. We are situated on the pier and we have a fantastic view of the Cattewater and you can also see Jennycliffe bay which is out in the Sound. If you are looking to go and watch the sailing then you can walk up onto the Hoe to a great spot about two minutes away from the club. During the championship the club will be open for Breakfast, teas and coffees throughout the day, the bar will also be open, lunch if you are not sailing, food after sailing up until about nine and also the bar will be open every night after sailing until people start to leave. On the Friday night we will be having a commodore's reception which everyone is welcome to come to and on Saturday we have some live entertainment. We are fortunate enough to have large car park next to the club which is where you can store your boat for the championship. The car park will be closed off for public access.

The club has a bar, a lounge area, a kitchen, computer access connected to the internet, and not forgetting the changing rooms with showers and toilets.

DIRECTIONS

Take the M5 and then A38. At Marsh Mills branch left (signposted Plymouth), then at Marsh Mills Roundabout take 1st exit onto Plymouth Road A374 (signed City Centre). Stay on A374, following signs for City Centre. After 3.2 miles, at traffic lights branch left onto Breton Side B3240 (signed Torpoint A372). After 0.1 miles, at mini-roundabout turn left onto Vauxhall Street (still B3240). After 0.2 miles turn left onto Exchange Street. Then left into Quay Rd and bear left onto Barbican. After 0.2m turn left onto Madeira Rd. Mayflower SC is on left side, by Elphinstone Car Park. Citadel on your right. If you turn sharp right onto the sea front: you have just passed it!
