Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.
2. The provision of safety equipment and boats by Saundersfoot Sailing Club is neither a guarantee that assistance can be rendered to any competitor in need, nor an acceptance of any responsibility for rescue of competitors. Further, in the event that assistance is rendered to any competitor, no liability for any loss, damage or injury to the competitor and/or the boat and its equipment is accepted by either the Club or the crew of such craft.
3. The attention of all competitors is drawn to R.R.S Fundamental Rule 4: **“Decision to Race. A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or continue racing.”**
4. It is understood that if the boat is in the charge of any person other than the competitor completing the declaration overleaf, it is this competitor’s responsibility to bring the attention of the person in charge of the boat to the provisions of this entry form.
5. Where the competitor is under 18 years of age a consent form must be obtained from Saundersfoot Sailing Club and completed by the person with parental responsibility as defined under the Childrens Act, before the event commences.
