NOTICE OF RACE

Competitors should note that Llandudno Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012) or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of the RYA national authority will apply:

- 1.3 The Sailing Instructions will apply.
- 1.4 Racing rule 40 will be changed - Use of personal buoyancy
The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.5 The RYA Arbitration of the RYA Disputes procedure will be available.

3 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY AND ENTRY FEES AND CONTACTS

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Supernova class
- 3.2 Helmsmen shall be current members of the Supernova Class Association.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration will be at Llandudno Sailing Club on Thursday 1st July from 17.00hrs to 21.00 hrs and Friday 2nd July from 09.00 hrs until 30 minutes before the start of the first race.

4.2 Dates and times of Racing

For the Championship two races will be scheduled for the Friday , three races for the Saturday and two races for Sunday. The scheduled time for the first race on Friday is 13.00 hrs.

5 MEASUREMENTS

All boats must comply with the Supernova Class Measurement Rule dates 24th August 2009.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 17.00 hrs on Thursday 1st July at the Race Office at Llandudno Sailing Club and may be available on the Supernova Association Web Site beforehand.

7 VENUE

Llandudno Sailing Club, Irving Road, Llandudno LL30 1BB

The directions are to exit Jct 19 of A55, follow signs to Llandudno (A470). At the fifth roundabout (end of section of dual carriageway), turn right. Proceed to Promenade. Map available on web site www.llandudno-sailing-club.org.uk

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions and available on Thursday 1st July at 17.00hrs at the Race Office at Llandudno Sailing Club.

8.1 The courses will be sailed in Llandudno Bay.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 9.1 The penalties are as follows: As detailed in RRS 44 except that there shall be no Scoring Penalties.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply unmodified.
- 10.2 If 7 races are sailed, a boats series score will be her 5 best scores. If 6 races are sailed, a boats series score will be her 5 best scores. If 5 races are sailed, a boats series score will be her 4 best scores. If 4 or less races are sailed, a boats series score will comprise of all the races sailed.

11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded by the Supernova Class Association.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race and Appendix J Addendum A (RYA) sections 1-5 inclusive The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million per event or the equivalent.
