Supernova Class Open Meeting

1. RYA Racing Charter

1.1 Competitors should note that Severn Sailing Club has adopted the RYA racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book (Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012), on the official Severn sailing Club notice board or at www.rya.org.uk/racing/charter.

2. Rules

2.1 Races will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 except as they are changed by the sailing instructions, class rules, the prescriptions of the RYA and this Notice of Race

3. Conditions of Entry

3.1 The safety of the boat and its entire management, including insurance shall Be the sole responsibility of the competitor(s) racing the boat.

3.2 All craft on the club premises (on land and on the water) must have full insurance cover, including third party liability to £2,000,000. All craft intended to be used for racing must have appropriate insurance cover.

3.3 The race organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or Personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew, as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his yacht for the race or races.

4. Organising Authority

4.1 The organising authority is Severn Sailing Club.

5. Entry and Registration

5.1 The entry fee for the event will be £7.00 excluding food

5.2 Boats shall be entered by completing registration with the organising Authority and shall produce a completed entry form and entry fee.

5.3 All boats entering the regatta shall be scored, however membership of the Supernova Dinghy Class Association is required to score in the travellers circuit. Helms should declare where they are class members when registering.

6. Event and Programme

6.1 There will be a briefing for all competitors at 11:00 AM on day of race

6.2 3 races are scheduled of which 2 constitute a series. If 3 races are sailed 2 will count towards the result. If only 2 races are sailed then both races will count towards the result.

6.3 The Schedule of racing is as follows:

- Race 1, 11.30AM

- Lunch
- Race 2 no earlier than 13:30
- Race 3 will be as soon after race 2 as practically possible.

These are subject to alteration at the discretion of the Organising Authority

7. Advertising and Sponsorship

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

8. The Course

The courses will be displayed on the race officers hut and sailed on the River Avon.

9. Scoring

Points

The low point scoring system will apply as set out in RRS 2009-2012

10. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.

11. Supernova Class Association Class Rules.

This event is open to non class members but their results are not included in the Supernova Travellers Series.
