NOTICE OF RACE for Supernova and Europe Open

from 21 to 22 May 2011

The Organising Authority (OA) is Weston Sailing Club

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Class Rules shall apply

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 Competitors shall enter by completing the entry form on the 1st day of the regatta and paying the required fee.
- 2.2 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration.
- 2.3 The regatta is open to all boats of the Supernova and Europe classes. There is no restriction on the number of entries.

3. Fees

- 3.1 The entry fee is £30 and includes a non-refundable element for an evening meal on Saturday.
- 3.2 Cheques are to be made payable to Weston Sailing Club.

4. Format and Schedule

- 4.1 Registration will open from 10:00 on the 1st day of the regatta at the office in the clubhouse.
- 4.2 The regatta will consist of 6 (six) races.
- 4.3 3 races are scheduled for each day, sailed back to back.
- 4.4 The starting time of the first race will not be before 12:30 on Saturday
- 4.5 A briefing will be held an hour before the scheduled first race.
- 4.6 On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 17:00.

5. Measurement

- 5.1 All boats shall carry individual numbers on their sails.
- 5.2 Boats may be subject to inspection at any time during the event.

6. Sailing Instructions and Courses

- **6.1** Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.
- **6.2** The courses will be announced on the day.

7. Venue

- **7.1** The regatta will be at Weston Sailing Club, Southampton
- **7.2** The racing area will be within Southampton Water.

8. Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing.

9. Prizes

- **9.1** Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each event.
- **9.2** Other prizes maybe issued by the class associations or the OA as it sees fit.
- **9.3** The prize giving ceremony will be in or near the clubhouse as soon as possible after the completion of the last race.

10. Insurance

Each participating boat shall have valid insurance of third-party liability coverage of at least 2,000,000 GBP (or equivalent) per incident.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor ISAF will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Media Rights

By participating in an event competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority, their sponsors and ISAF the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
