NOTICE OF RACE (NoR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The ESC club rules and bylaws, and Exe Water Users Code of conduct applies.
- 1.3. Competitors should note that ESC implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be expected to sail in compliance with it.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1. Sailing Instructions will be published on the Official Notice Board by 0001 hours 19th May 2022

3. COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. The online official notice board is located on the Exe Sailing Club website <https://exe-sailing-club.org/open-events.html>

- 3.2. [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Racing will take place in Supernova Class dinghies. All Traveller Series competitors must be members of the Supernova Class Association. All boats must comply with the Supernova class rules as amended by the class association. Local host club Supernova helms may compete but their results will not count towards Traveller Series results unless they are Supernova Class members.
- 4.2. Eligible competitors can enter by completing the entry form found on the official notice board <https://exe-sailing-club.org/open-events.html> and forward to Nick Coombes at sailing@exe-sailing-club.org. Additionally, forms can be completed at registration.

Any competitors aged under 18 shall complete an Under 18s Consent Form which can be found at : https://exe-sailing-club.org/assets/documents/Shared/consent_2021_v2.pdf

4. FEES

- 5.1. Entry fee for the event will be £15:00 payable at registration.

6. CREW LIMITATIONS - Does not apply

7. ADVERTISING - Does not apply

8. QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES - Does not apply

9. SCHEDULE

- 9.1 Early Arrival Friday 20th May 1900hrs to 2000hrs (boat drop off)
- 9.2. Arrival (boat drop off, parking is available off site) and Registration: Saturday 21st May 0800hrs to 1000hrs
- 9.3. Competitor Briefing: Saturday 21st May 1000hrs
- 9.4. Races: 3 back to back races at sea with first warning signal scheduled for 1125hrs
- 9.5 No warning signals will be made after 1530hrs

10. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

11. CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

- 11.1. RRS 40.1 applies at all times when competitors are afloat.

- 11.2. Tally Bands will be issued to the helm and shall be worn all day when competitors are afloat.
- 11.3. (NP&DP) Competitors to have on board a separate rope specific for towing purposes only. The rope is to be of at least 7m in length and no less than 6mm in diameter.

12. VENUE

- 12.1. Dinghy Racing will take place at sea in Lyme Bay see appendix A.

13. COURSES

- 13.1. Courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

14. PENALTY SYSTEM - Does not apply

15. SCORING

- 15.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute an event.
- 15.2. There will be one discard if 3 races are completed.
- 15.3. There will be no discards if less than 3 races are completed.
- 15.4. RSS A5.3 applies.

16. SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 16.1. [DP]All crews of Support Person Vessels should make their presence know to the Race Officer and follow any directions given.

17. CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS - Does not apply

18. BERTHING

- 18.1. Boats will be stored on their road trailers and assigned a space as directed by the berthing marshal. Car parking is off site for the duration of the event.

19. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS - Does not apply

20. DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS - Does not apply

21. DATA PROTECTION

- 21.1. The Exe SC Data Privacy & Processing Policy and our Conditions of Use of Photographs, Video & Images are available on the club website.
- 21.2. Photographs may be taken during the event, which may be posted on social media and/or used in press releases. Competitors consent for the use of images of themselves/their boats is required on the entry form.

22. RISK STATEMENT

- 22.1. RRS 3 states: The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in any of the events covered by this notice of race, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
 - b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
 - c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
 - d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
 - e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
 - f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
 - g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules or information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event;
- 22.2. [NP/DP] While taking part in any of the races covered by this NoR, all competitors are responsible for complying with any COVID-19 regulations and Exe SC COVID-19 guidance.

23. INSURANCE

- 23.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

24. PRIZES

- 24.1. Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- 24.2. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
