1. Rules

- 1.1. The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the event's Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Competitors should note that Burton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.
- 1.3. By entering and attending this event, all persons agree to abide by the Rules of Burton Sailing Club.

2. Advertising

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. The race is open to any Supernova dinghy with a valid Measurement Certificate.
- 3.2. Registration is on the day but preregistration by Midnight Wednesday 13th is requested via: https://forms.office.com/r/p0qxJSqL7e
- 3.3. Entry fees will be £25 per boat (includes a complimentary breakfast cob and unlimited tea and coffee for competitors for the day)

4. Open Schedule

- 4.1. A briefing will be held at 10.15am outside of the clubhouse.
- 4.2. The 1st warning signal shall not be before 10:55.
- 4.3. 3 races are intended for the event. Race times are subject to change and any variation will be posted on the noticeboard board near the clubhouse.
- 4.4. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:30

5.1. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series and there will be one discard if three races have been completed.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the BSC website and one hour before the first briefing, on the Official Noticeboard. No paper copies will be provided to competitors.

7. Prizes

7.1. Prizes will be awarded for the first three places overall

8. Disclaimer

8.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority (Burton Sailing Club) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained prior to, during, or after the event.

9. Insurance

9.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third-Party Liability Insurance with a Minimum Cover of £3 million.

NOTICE TO ALL VISITORS - Invasive Species Procedure.

Before launching, all competitors are required to ensure that your boat has been 'Checked, Cleaned and Dried' for a minimum of two days prior to arriving at Burton Sailing Club. It is imperative that the Check, Clean, and Dry principles are adhered to before the boat is launched elsewhere to prevent the spread of the non-native species to other locations in the UK.

ACCOMMODATION

Dogs are allowed on site but must be under control at all times and are not permitted in the clubhouse or training centre.

SITE ACCESS & PARKING

The car park nearest to the club house is for members and visitors. Cars are permitted within the dinghy park to allow dropping or collection of boats and equipment but must be removed **immediately** to a designated car parking area.

GALLEY

The Galley will be serving food and hot drinks until lunchtime on Saturday.

The entry fee includes a complimentary breakfast cob and unlimited tea and coffee for competitors for the day. Lunch can be booked and paid for at registration.

The bar will be open after sailing.

MEMBERSHIP

Entrants and authorized guests are temporary members of Burton Sailing Club during the period of the event and shall comply with Club Rules and Bye-laws. Failure to observe these Rules and Bye-laws may result in the imposition of penalties, including disqualification from the event.
