1 Rules

The Racing and conduct of the event will be governed by the "Rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-2028 except as they are changed by the Emberton Park SC sailing instructions, class rules, the prescriptions of the RYA and this Notice of Race. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted on the notice board on the day. RRS 27.1 and 40; will be changed to the effect that buoyancy aids will be worn at all times afloat.

2 Eligibility and Entry

The event is open to all boats of the Supernova class. Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry form ([Online form](#)) or emailing the Entry form to the Commodore commodore@epsc.org.uk there will be a restriction of 25 boats a waiting list will operate should we reach this number. Your place will be secured on receipt of entry form and payment, details are on the entry form.

The entry fee for the event will be £17.00 payable via bank transfer, this includes Breakfast, Lunch and galley beverages for sailors. There will be a small charge for additional guests.

3 Event and Programme

Sailing will take place on Heron Lake within Emberton Country Park and provides a welcoming and relaxing atmosphere in which to sail. The lake is small and provides challenging sailing within a safe environment. The Park provides entertainment for the whole family visit:

There will be a briefing for all competitors no earlier than 10:30 and prize-giving will be after the final race.

The first race will start no earlier than 11:00

Sailing instructions will be available in the clubhouse.

The Course to be sailed will be displayed at the club.

Races will be scheduled of which a minimum of 2 will constitute a series. If 3 races are sailed 2 will count. If 2 races are sailed, both will count.

4 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3, Decision to Race.

The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

5 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3.0 million per event or the equivalent.

6 RYA Racing Charter

Competitors should note that Emberton Park Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found on the RYA website [Racing Charter](#).

Social The galley will be open for breakfast, lunch and refreshments. The bar will be open for refreshments and snacks.

Entry to the Park The gatehouse is usually manned from 09:00 at the weekend and I will inform them of our visitors so they should let you through the barrier.

How to find the Club Turn Right immediately after the barrier at the gatehouse, over a speed ramp and left turn to the Sailing Club.

Parking is available in the club car park. Boats should be rigged in the car park and walked on their launching trolleys to the slipway. Parking is also available in the meadow just outside the club compound and around the Country Park. Parking is permitted on the grass but be aware of current weather conditions can be boggy if very wet.

Security Valuables should not be left in the changing rooms or visible in cars free lockers are available in the clubhouse.

Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times within the Sailing Club compound and are not allowed into the Clubhouse building. Every precaution should be taken to ensure that they are not allowed to foul the site or member's property.
