Temporary Clauses to HSC Notice Of Race During Covid-19 Emergency

Take care to minimise the risk of transmission of the Covid-19 virus by:

Maintaining social distancing of 2 metres or 1metre+ in accordance with current government guidelines at all times and especially at the launch and recovery of boats after the races.

Only one boat at a time on the ramp, avoid gatherings of more than 6 people at any time at launch and recovery.

Launch each boat separately before your start time for the race. Recover each boat separately and be especially careful at the end of the race when there are likely to be more boats at the slipways.

Avoid touching other people's boats.

Only sail doublehander boats with another member of your household or bubble.

Remember:

It is your responsibility to ensure that you are competent to sail in the prevailing weather conditions at the time of the race so that we can have minimal involvement of the safety boat. It is likely that the safety boat will be only manned by one person and physical contact between safety boat crew and a sailor in the water will only happen in a real emergency.

If you capsize and have to be assisted to right the boat or to get back into it you will be required to retire from the race.
