Notice of Race

1. Organising authority

The organising authority is Snettisham Beach Sailing Club.

2. Rules

The *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) will govern this regatta. Snettisham Beach Sailing Club has adopted *The R.Y.A Racing Charter*.

3. Classes and eligibility

Racing will take place in Supernova Class dinghies. All Traveller Series competitors must be members of the Supernova Class Association. All boats must comply with the Supernova class rules as amended by the class association.

4. Times

The Club grounds will open from 12.00pm on Friday 3rd May

Registration will take place at Snettisham Beach Sailing Club from 15.30 to 17.00 on Saturday 4th May.

There will be a briefing for competitors outside the clubhouse at 16.15 hours, or as soon as possible afterwards.

Races will be sailed back to back each day

The first race on Saturday 4th May is scheduled to start at 17.40, Second and Third Race times to be advised on the water. HW 18.55, Height in feet 23.53

The first race on Sunday 5th May is scheduled to start at 07.05, Second and Third Race times to be advised on the water. HW 07.20 Height in feet 23.37

The number of races and timing is indicative and will depend on weather conditions.

Prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after racing has finished on Sunday.

Competitors are invited to join club sailing/racing on:

Friday 3rd May Start time: 17.45

Monday 6th May Start time 07.50

5. Entries

The entry fee for the event is £35.00 which will include food and drinks as noted below.

SBSC regrets that it is not able to take card payments at the moment, transactions will require cash or cheque.

All competitors must complete the official entry form

All competitors with a medical condition that may affect them while sailing are required to complete a medical declaration form. The medical declaration form will be available at registration.

All competitors under the age of 18 years at the time of the event are required to complete a parental declaration form, signed by their parent or guardian, in addition to an entry form. The parental declaration form will be available at registration.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions have been sent to the class association, some copies will also be available upon registration at Snettisham Beach Sailing Club from 15.30 hours on the 4th May

7. Racing Area

The racing area will be that of Snettisham Beach Sailing Club as defined in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Rights to Use Names and Likenesses

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of, or relating to the event. They also allow their names, age category, club and boat details to be displayed in competitors lists prior to the event and in results, on the Snettisham Beach Sailing Club website and in other publications.

9. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded on the day for at least 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and overall.
The organisers reserve the right to decide eligibility for prizes.

10. Coaches & Supporters

No coach or support boats will be permitted. Coaches & supporters accompanying competitors are required to comply with: The principles of good sportsmanship and behaviour and the rules of Snettisham Beach Sailing Club. Failure to do so may result in investigation by the regatta organisers, and potentially in an instruction to leave the premises of Snettisham Beach Sailing Club.

All races can be viewed from the clubhouse or beach area.

Dogs are to be kept on leads at all times during the event as the club grounds may be busy at this time. Dogs are not permitted inside the clubhouse.

11. Safety

Please be aware that personal flotation must be worn by anyone going afloat, this is a vital safety rule of Snettisham Beach SC.
Care should be taken on the beach when assisting in launch/recovery of dinghies. Personal flotation devices are advised.

12. Points system

One race is required to be completed to constitute an event. There will be one discard if three races or more races have been completed and no discards if less than three races are completed.
The low points system as provided in RRS Appendix A will apply

13. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 for any one accident and shall sign a declaration to that effect before going afloat.

14. Food and Drink

A Bacon roll and cup of tea/coffee will be available after sailing on Sunday 5th May. This is included within the entry fee for competitors. Additional food will also be available on Friday evening, Saturday after racing (please order when registering), Sunday brunch after racing and Monday brunch after racing.

The club has a well stocked bar – please feel free to drink it dry!

15. Camping

The club offers free camping and campervan parking. Space is not, however, infinite, so it is offered on a first come first served basis and cannot be guaranteed. There are also a number of campsites close to the club. The club showers and toilets will be available for those camping. Please see the 'Welcome' document with this NoR.
