



## Supernova Sea Championship

Exe SC- 22nd & 23rd May 2021

**(Subject to restrictions being lifted as per the Government's roadmap)**

### Sea Training Day 21<sup>ST</sup> May (free to members)

Training will be headed up by RYA coach Alistair Goodwin, with local Exe SC sailor and 2017 National Champion Alex Horlock on hand to offer advice on Sea sailing techniques for the supernova. Timings will be issued closer to the event.

### Sea Championship - 6 Races at Sea over 2 days

The event provides an excellent opportunity to practice sea sailing techniques ahead of the Nationals.

To accommodate those travelling on the day there will be a late morning launch on day 1 of the event

Sailing Club Bar & Restaurant will be open in the evening (covid restrictions permitting)

**Please note-** The event is limited to 50 competitors and registration/payment will be online only via Exe SC website as per above link Notice of race/Entry form. For anyone without a printer who would prefer a word version of the Entry Form, one is attached at the end of this document. Unfortunately parking at ESC is very limited and much of the car park will be taken up with visitors boats and those volunteering to assist with the event. As such there is no car parking available at the Club, although there is a local authority car park approx. 200m distance from the Club, or alternatively cars can be parked at the nearby Rugby Club which is also available for those who wish to camp – see below.

### Camping

For those attending the Sea Championships at Exe and would like to camp/motorhome, an area for 20 units/tents will be available at the nearby Rugby Club which is only a short distance walk from the Sailing Club from Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> onwards. Facilities are basic but will include toilets, showers, Chemical toilet disposal and fresh water, plus of course there are good showers available at the SC.

The cost of camping will be £9 per night per family unit, to include family tent/motorhome, plus car. There will also be space for parking for those not camping who do not wish to use the nearby local Authority car parks, at a cost of £5 per 24hrs (There is no parking available at the Sailing Club). Bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis and payment for either camping or car parking only and will need to be paid in advance via bank transfer.
