

Directions and Car Parking

Directions

After leaving the M5 at junction 30 follow the signs for Exmouth (A376)

Remain on the A376 into the Town leaving the Bus Station on your right.

Take the 2nd exit at the roundabout, and 2nd exit again at the next roundabout into Langerwehe Way. Turn right and then left into Shelly Reach which becomes Shelly Road. Look for the Sailing Club on your right.

Parking

We are sorry but Exe SC has only a small car park which will largely be used for parking the dinghies taking part in the event and club members voluntarily giving up their time to run the event. Any remaining spaces will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

On arrival you will be met outside the club entrance where club members will help you unhitch your boat and move your boat on its road trailer base to a dinghy parking position at the club. Please make sure you have any tools, boat parts, sailing gear etc that you need readily to hand so that they can be put on the boat before it is wheeled into position. If necessary you will then need to move your car to one of the nearby car parks.

The Rugby Club

Exmouth Rugby Club have agreed to let us use their car park for £5 per car per day (24hrs). This car park is about 8 mins walk from Exe SC. Payment will need to be made at registration. For those sailors camping at the Rugby Club, parking is included in the cost of your pitch.

Camperdown Terrace Long Stay Car Park

Camperdown Car Park is run by East Devon Council as a long stay car park, it has 66 spaces but is quite well used by the local public. The charges are 50p per 30 mins with a maximum payment of £6 for 24 hrs. You can also buy a 2 day permit at £12, a 3 day permit at £15, or a 4 day permit for £20. This car park is about 5 mins walk from Exe SC.

Imperial Road Recreational Ground Long Stay Car Park

Another East Devon Council run car park the Estuary car park has the same charging structure as Camperdown Terrace. This car park is about 10 mins walk from Exe SC.
