Notice of Race - 28th/29th May 2016



Supernova Travellers Event

1. **Rules:** Races will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013 – 2016 except as they are changed by published sailing instructions, Class Rules, the prescriptions of the RYA and this Notice of Race. Competitors should note that Exe SC implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter.
2. **Conditions of Entry:** The safety of a boat shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat, who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions, nor the inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for his/her crew his/her boat and the management thereof. The race organizers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor, helm or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his/her boat for the race or races.
All boats entered must hold a valid, current Certificate of Insurance, which covers the boat for the period of the event and in particular must hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000.
3. **Eligibility:** The event is open to boats of the Supernova class only.
4. **Entry & Fee:** Entry is on the day from 10.00 in the ground floor training room.
Fee £30 (cash or cheque).

Mini briefing - 09.30
Launch - 10.00
Start -11.00 approx

6. **Courses:** Details and diagrams for the courses to be sailed will be contained within the SI. Sailing will take place at sea unless conditions dictate otherwise
7. **Scoring:** The Low Points scoring System (Appendix A) will be used to award points and to resolve ties.
8. **Prizes:** Will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed boats. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.
9. **Detailed Sailing Instructions:** The SI will be available to view on Exe SC Website and on the Class Association website (Hard copies available on the day).
10. **Galley/Bar:** Refreshments will be available each morning and on return from sailing. The Restaurant and Bar will be open on Friday and Saturday evening.
