Here's something that I changed on my current boat. There is a number of ways of doing this but basically, I have removed the clew hook from the back of the sail where it attaches to the arrangement outhaul. On more than one occasion I have managed to get the hook caught on someone else's forestay or shroud. It happen to me on a start line when I let my sail out and someone luffed up into my boom and their forestay rubbed down the boom and got caught on the hook......what a nightmare, really hard to unhook without capsizing and possible damage when the boats get pulled together.
